BONFIRE RULES

No bonfires without the prior approval of the Oak Grove Beach Community Association Board of Directors. Please contact a current Board member who will notify the full Board of the date of the fire.

The East Lyme Fire Department must be notified BEFORE lighting fire and AFTER fire is put out. They can be reached at (860) 739-2420.

All fires must be contained; we suggest the use of a fire ring, either purchased or made of rocks, or a fire pan placed in a hole in the sand.

Burn only clean, unprocessed, unpainted/unstained firewood. No driftwood, grass, trash or glass. Wood should be free from nails and other hardware.

Keep fire a manageable size and in control. Fire must be tended to at all times by a responsible adult; minors must be supervised. Be mindful of wind conditions and blowing sparks.

Do not bury hot embers or debris. Allow fire to burn out completely, leaving only ashes. Have a bucket and shovel on hand and use *Drown*, *Stir*, *Feel: Drown* the ashes with water; *stir* the ashes with shovel; *feel* the ashes for heat. If there is any heat at all, repeat until all heat is gone; ashes must be cold before leaving.

Ashes and debris must be removed to the dump the next day by 10am. Debris MUST NOT be thrown in the water or OGB garbage cans.

All other OGB beach rules and regulations also apply.
